ASK A DERM

Q What are cleansing oils, and who should use them?

A "Cleansing oils are designed to dissolve and remove makeup and should be used before you wash your face with a traditional cleanser," says Dr. Lisa Kellett of DLK on Avenue (www.dlkonavenue.com). "If your cleanser is not getting all your makeup off, you can incorporate a cleansing oil into your skin-care routine. It's a gentler alternative to a cleansing scrub, which can dry and irritate. It's also ideal for dry and sensitive skin types. Those with oily skin should opt for an exfoliating cleanser to get the same results."
